Middle Flint Area Community Service Board d/b/a to Middle Flint Health & Wellness is pleased to announce the re-opening of the Phoenix Pointe Crisis Stabilization Unit, effective May 1, 2023.

The Phoenix Pointe CSU admissions will be limited to four (4) beds for the initial opening and will increase bed admissions slowly as staff works to get re-acclimated to the critical care service environment. This unit provides walk-in Emergency Receiving and Evaluating twenty-four hours each day.
